



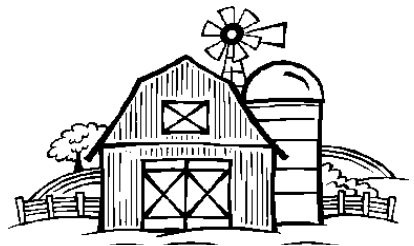

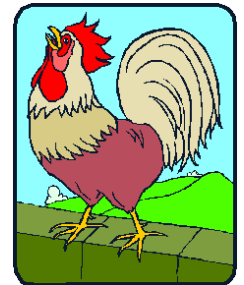

Directions: From Lexington, take I-64 East to exit 35 (Shelbyville); take a right off the ramp & go straight for approximately 15 miles; turn right on Hwy 421; fairgrounds are 1 mile on left. From Louisville area, take I-71 North to exit 28 (Pendleton); turn right off the ramp & go 0.2 miles to Hwy 146; turn left onto Hwy. 146 & go to New Castle; turn right at stoplight onto Hwy. 55/421 & go 2 miles; turn left on Hwy. 421; fairgrounds are 1 mile on left.
